

Bairds Mainfreight Primary School



PURPOSE

The purpose of the scholarship programme is to provide financial support to past students of Bairds Mainfreight Primary School, who want to pursue and achieve success in their learning at secondary school/college.

THE SCHOLARSHIPS

There will be up to five scholarships awarded annually.

The secondary scholarships are worth \$500 per annum, which is to go towards school fees, uniforms, textbooks or study related travel. The scholarships are awarded annually and may be renewed for up to five consecutive years.

The awarding of a scholarship for the second and subsequent years is dependent on evidence of satisfactory results & progress being provided to the Mainfreight Scholarship Board.

Applicants applying for the Mainfreight Secondary Scholarship must:

- be attending or intending to enrol at an Aotearoa/NZ Secondary School
- be attending full time study for the year being applied for
- meet all criteria for the scholarship
- submit their application and supporting documentation on time
- have the signed support of their parent or legal guardian (see declaration)

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Applicants applying for Mainfreight Secondary Scholarships must:

- have attended Bairds Mainfreight Primary School for at least three yearsthese years must have been from Years 3-6
- be enrolled at or have applied for enrolment at a NZ secondary school for the period of the scholarship;
- be attending full-time study for the full year
- twice a year provide certified copies of their results to the tumuaki/principal of BMPS
- submit the application and supporting documentation on time
