

Bairds Mainfreight Primary School

Mainfreight Tertiary School Scholarships



PURPOSE

The purpose of the scholarship programme is to provide financial support to past students of Bairds Mainfreight Primary School, who want to pursue and achieve their chosen course of tertiary study or accredited work related study. Tertiary, generally means university or polytech courses. However, it may also include work related courses such as apprenticeships.

THE SCHOLARSHIPS

There will be up to three scholarships awarded annually.

The tertiary scholarships are worth up to \$3000 per annum, which is to go towards course fees, textbooks or study related travel.

The scholarships are awarded annually and may be renewed for up to three consecutive years.

The awarding of a scholarship for the second and third year is dependent on evidence of satisfactory results and progress being provided to the Mainfreight Scholarship Board.

Applicants applying for the Mainfreight Tertiary Scholarship must:

- be attending or intending to enrol in an Aotearoa/NZ tertiary course
- be attending full time study for the year being applied for
- meet all criteria for the scholarship
- submit their application & supporting documentation on time
- submit validated/authorised invoices/receipts to the Mainfreight Scholarship Board

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Applicants applying for Mainfreight Education Scholarships must:

- have attended Bairds Mainfreight Primary School for at least three yearsthese years must have been from Years 3-6
- be enrolled at or have applied for enrolment at a NZ tertiary course or similar accredited course, for the period of the scholarship
- be attending full-time study
- twice a year provide certified copies of their results to the tumuaki/principal of BMPS
- submit the application and supporting documentation on time
